POOL NEWS

Our pools are up and running! We had another successful opening on Memorial Day weekend, despite a few thunderstorms! Pool hours will begin on a "normal" schedule beginning Friday, June 9th. Please see the Pool Hours flyer in this newsletter for details.

Don't forget to bring the kids to the **Annual School's Out party!** There will be music, treats and fun!

Please remember to always bring your pool cards with you when coming to the pool—no card, no entry! Pool cards must not be given to non-residents for use at any time. If you are bringing guests to the pool, you must stay with them the entire visit.

If you missed the swim lesson sign ups, there's still time to register! If you'd like a class at the South Pool, a sign-up book is available at the guard station at that pool. If you'd like a class at the North Pool, find the book at the guard station at the North Pool!

Early morning lap swim begins on Tuesday, June 13th at the South Pool from 6:30-7:30am. The pool will be open for Forest Lakes adults only (bring your pool card!) on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday mornings through July.

LAWNS 'N WEEDS

It's that time of year when the grass in your yard seems to grow at sonic speed and the weeds grow at supersonic speed! It's up to every resident in Forest Lakes to take care of their lawns and surroundings. If you can't find the time to mow, hire someone! Help keep your property, your neighborhood. and Forest Lakes well-maintained. Mow the grass, pull the weeds, and don't leave items in your driveways or yard. Your neighbors and HOA thank you!

TRASHIN' IT

Looking ahead, there will be NO affect to our trash service for the 4th of July and Labor Day holidays. Our trash will be picked up on the normal Wednesday.

Please be sure to store your trash toter out of sight from the street. Also, remember toters are not to be brought out to the curb until the EVENING before trash pickup and taken in as soon as possible after trash has been picked up. All trash toters should be off the street and out of view by Wednesday evening. Thank you!

TENNIS LIGHTS

A new lighting system has been installed at both the north and south courts. Residents will need your gym card to activate the lights. Simply tap your card onto the box at the middle of each court to turn the lights on. They will stay on for 90 minutes. If you need them to stay on longer, tap the box with your card again. The activation system begins at 8:00pm. You will not be able to turn the lights on after midnight.

From the desk of Tennis Director, Jim Labinski

Dear Forest Lakes residents,

Too much rain lately for your tastes? I tend to look on the bright side of things.

After a rain shower, I can't begin to tell you what a joy it is to play on the Clay Tech courts at the Forest Lakes North tennis center. Here are a few tips to get the most out of your clay court experience:

Once it stops raining, give the courts about one to two hours of draining and the courts are ready for play. Once the puddles have disappeared, quite often the courts are "wash and wear." Or should I say, "dry and play."

If there was a lot of rain, often the clay court material "migrates" across the courts. The lines get caked over with material. The lines need to be scrubbed with the "toothbrush" shaped liner. Then it is a good idea to brush the courts to help "redistribute" the material evenly over the court.

Now the court will have a nice, even dark gray color. It is ready to be enjoyed—game on!

As the weather heats up however, we might not always have Mother Nature to water the courts for us. I suggest coming out a few minutes early and water your court. It's simple. If you come fifteen minutes early you can give it about 5-7 minutes of water, while you limber up. Come earlier, and give it more water! Or text ahead and I might be able to water the courts before your reservation. The courts play so much better when they have been watered!

Of course, when you are finished, be sure to brush and line the court you played on. Be sure to hang the brushes and liners on the fence, well off the ground. If the courts have dried out, set the time for five minutes of watering as you leave.

The spring showers have played havoc with the USTA teams of Forest Lakes. However, it appears that only a couple matches remain to be made up, much to the delight of the team captains.

The Spring After School Tennis Program has been a whopping success. Only a couple of make-up sessions remain. Parents, thank you so much for supporting your children's tennis development.

Now it is time to gear up for the Junior Summer Tennis Camp, which begins on Monday, June 12. There are nine-week, four-week, and single-week options. There are also one-, two- and three-hour per day options.

The Pro Shop is open! Come by and see the new tennis deck that will be finished soon! Stop in and see the new Dunlop Precision racket. Buy a can of tennis balls, or a junior racket for your toddler. Bring your racket by to get a new string job. Enjoy the shade as you watch a little tennis.

The new light switches have been installed at both north and south courts. Don't forget to bring your FLCA-issued card (the one that gets you into the fitness center) to the courts if you wish to play night tennis.

I urge all tennis players to "give the boot" to anyone using the courts that you know is not a Forest Lakes resident. If you are uncomfortable "giving them the boot," let me know and I will.

On behalf of the tennis players of Forest Lakes, I want to give a "SHOUT OUT" to the Hapgood family. They recently moved from Forest Lakes, but their impact on the Forest Lakes tennis scene was great.

Chris, looked out for the everyone's interests in all matters Forest Lakes (especially tennis), as he served for many years on the FLCA board. Pascale's spirited play and team captaincy will be missed on the north courts—though I'm sure she will be around playing with her Forest Lakes tennis mates. And the top junior players will fear no longer the wrath of Margaux's wicked backhand. Best wishes as you all pursue your future tennis endeavors at "a club on the other side of town."

The dog days of summer are nearly upon us. Respect the heat, stay hydrated and play a lot of tennis.



The Tropical Storms is a five week development program of the Forest Lakes Hurricanes Swim Team (FLST). It is designed to be an introduction to the competitive swim team. This program will provide the basics of competitive swim strokes. This program is not a substitute for swim lessons.

Tropical Storms are for children 4 years old and all <u>new</u> swimmers under 7 years old.

The program will introduce young swimmers to the swim team style of swimming and advance them to be able to swim at least 1 pool length (25 meters) of Freestyle and Backstroke. Level I (3 years and up) First class without a parent. Skills include floating, kicking, bobbing, arm movements, breath control, rolling over and safety. All skills are done with support.

Level 2 (3 years and up) Must have completed Level 1 skills. Skills emphasized are rhythmic breathing, unsupported front/back floats and glides, finning, front crawl, elementary backstroke and safety.

Level 3 (5 years and up) Must have completed Level 2 skills. Skills emphasized are front crawl with breathing to side, elementary backstroke, treading water, butterfly kick, scissor kick, survival float and diving.

Level 4 (6 years and up) Must have completed Level 3 skills. Skills emphasized are deep water bobbing, breast stroke, sidestroke, back crawl, butterfly and endurance in front crawl and elementary backstroke.

Level 5 (6 years and up) Must have completed Level 4 skills. Skills emphasized are endurance of previous skills, sculling, shallow and surface dives, flip turns and safety.

Parent Assisted Classes

Waterbabies/Aquatot (6 mos to 2 yrs) A great first class! Emphasis on water adjustment, safety and supported movement through the water.

Preschool (2 years to 3 years) Same skills as aquatot. Emphasis on breath control, jumping-in and beginner forms of propulsion.

Class size: minimum 6 children, maximum 12.

Late registration: Sign up books with listings of open classes will be available at the lifeguard tables at the pools beginning on Monday, May29th.

Swim lessons are taught in **two-week sessions** consisting of eight half-hour classes each session. There are two built-in make-up days per session in case of inclement weather.






