Please make sure all yard toys are picked up each evening, no boats or trailers are parked in your driveway or street, trash toters are taken off the street after collection, and your yard and house are in good appearance. THE DMV....IT'S COMING BACK!

February's DMV visit was a huge success-maybe too huge! The response was so great that it was impossible for the staff to get through all patrons. The mobile DMV will be back on Tuesday, April 16th at the North Pavilion from 1:00-6:00pm. They'll have more staff on hand. They will not be taking phone numbers and calling patrons back this go around. They provide all services except for driver testing. If you are interested in getting a "Real ID" the documents you will need are: 1) Official birth certificate from a state vital records department, (NOT the one from the hospital with footprints on the paper) If you have changed your name as a result of marriage DMV will need the marriage license, not from the church but the official one issued by the clerk of court. A valid passport with current legal name can take the place of birth certificate and marriage license 2) Proof of social security number- must be the actual card, a W-2, a 1099, or another official letter from SSA with the full SSN on the letter. A tax filling form such as a 1040 is not acceptable, it must come from SSA not something you send to the IRS. 3) Two proofs of address/residency, if address is correct on your driver's license or ID card that will count as proof. The second proof can be anything that comes in the mail with name and address on it.

SPRING BULK PICKUP AND SHRED DATES

Start planning now — clean out those closets, desk drawers and back yards and garages for the annual Bulk Pick Up and Shredding days! Shredding will be held at the North Pool parking lot on Friday, April 19th from 10:00am -2:00pm. Please make sure your shredding papers are free of paperclips and paper binders.

Bulk pickup will be the following day, Saturday, April 20th, beginning at 7am. You may dispose of regular household items such as small furniture, bags of trash, small metal items such as toasters, small televisions, etc. Please limit your materials to weigh no more than 50lbs per item and have your materials curbside for removal by 7am. Materials EXCLUDED: Computers, printers, monitors and like equipment; large appliances such as washers, dryers, water heaters, stoves or motorized equipment; rocks, concrete, dirt, sod, tree stumps, free liquids, paint, motor oil, construction trash/renovation debris, combustibles, toxic or hazardous wastes, or any other material excluded from the disposal site or any applicable state or federal law as being

hazardous or toxic (asbestos, paint or gasoline) as well as flammable products such as petrol chemicals or propane tanks from barbeque grills; dead animals, fecal matter, manure, brick, landscaping timbers, friable asbestos, lead acid/wet cell batteries, bio hazardous material, needles and ALL other medical waste.

If you rent a home in Forest Lakes, you need to bring in your executed lease with this form. If the FLCA Office doesn't have a current lease on file, you will not be receiving pool cards

PICKING UP AFTER YOUR PETS

It is every Forest Lakes resident's duty, as a responsible pet owner, to pick up after their pet. This includes on common areas, in yards (including your own), on or near the trails/paved walking paths, in or near the woods, on the sidewalks, in the day or night, in the cold or heat. Every time and anywhere your pet goes, it needs to be picked up, carried away and put in the trash. Parents, if you let your child/teenager walk your dog, teach them to pick up as well. If they cannot pick up waste, they should not walk the pet!

Not only is leaving pet waste on the ground an unwelcome mess, it increases public health risks by allowing harmful bacteria and excess nutrients to wash into storm drains and eventually into local water bodies. In Forest Lakes, there are several lakes and many creeks and streams that pet waste will eventually run into. Something to consider the next time you don't pick up after your pet – no matter how big or small the waste. FLCA has also put many trash bins throughout our community for easy disposal of bagged waste.

So please, be considerate and pick up after your pet! It's the right thing to do and......

- Mailboxes is yours discolored, dented or just plain old-looking? Replace it! You can find them at Lowe's large, black metal 11" x 23 ½".
- Mailbox Posts A fresh coat of WHITE paint is always a good bet for spring. Scrub off the green stuff and dirt and paint with a good outdoor white paint. Be sure to paint your name and house letters in black!

FOREST LAKES TENNIS NEWS - MARCH 2019

FROM THE DESK OF JIM LABINSKI, DIRECTOR OF TENNIS

Dear Forest Lakes residents,

I'm so excited that March will be a busy month around the tennis courts of Forest Lakes. USTA league matches, team practices, and after school juniors will be getting into full stride in the upcoming weeks.

Court reservation sheets

With the increased traffic on the courts, it is ESSENTIAL to check and use the court reservation sheets provided at the Pro Shop at North and at the reservation sheet box located at the entrance to court one at South. Matches, clinics, lessons and practices will be clearly marked on the sheets about a week in advance. I also put out "Court reserved for..." announcements at the gates of the courts on the day of the event. Please respect your neighbors and check the sheets before taking a court. Or risk getting "bumped." Also, court one at South and court five at North are "permanently" reserved for lessons, thank you.

Court courtesies

Just a friendly reminder... Refrain from bad language, temper outbursts, and the like. (People notice!) Brush and line your court at North after playing. Limit play to one hour for singles, and one-and-a-half hours for doubles when people are waiting. (Hopefully that will be a non-issue when using the reservation sheets!) Place your trash in the receptacles. Recycle your tennis balls in the carton by the Pro Shop. There is a small basket for other recyclables at the Pro Shop.

Spring After School Junior Tennis

There remain available openings for the Forest Lakes After School Tennis clinics which begins Monday, March 11. This will be an eight-week program, with a free week added for make-ups. (Nine weeks for the price of eight!) There is also a four-week option. Participants can opt in for one, two or three times per week. Forms are available on the Forest Lakes Community Association website, at the FLCA office, or at the Pro Shop. Call, text or email me to get more information.

"Swing into Spring" adult tennis clinics

If you don't participate in USTA league tennis, don't be left out of the action! In March, I will be implementing the new "pilot program" for residents and their guests to "Swing into Spring." Swing into Spring will be a four-session course of hour-long lessons. These classes are designed to introduce the adult participants to the great sport of tennis. These lessons will also be a great way for former players to get back into the game. The first session introduces the forehand groundstroke. The second focuses on the backhand. The third session zooms in on specialty shots, and the fourth lesson "puts it all together." I call it a "pilot program" as I want to see if there is a desire for non-USTA participation by "recreational players." Call, text or email me for more information.

Instruction/coaching options

In addition to the after-school program and the Swing into Spring program, I will be conducting 3.0 Women's Team practice on Mondays at 6:30. I will also be conducting 3.5 Women's Team practice on Tuesdays at 7:30. On Thursdays at 7:30, I will conduct an Advanced Men's workout. I am also available for lessons by appointment. An hour-long private lesson is \$50. A six-pack of hour lessons is \$250. A half-hour lesson is \$30, and a six-pack of half-hour lessons is \$150. Call, text or email me to schedule a lesson.

ZEN TENNIS AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM AT FOREST LAKES 2019 SPRING 8-WEEK Youth Tennis Program BEGINS Monday, March 11, 2019

<u>Beginners I, II and III</u> (Guidelines) Player has little or no experience. Beginner I is for very young players, Beginner II is for slightly older beginners. Beginners III is for beginners that are 12 or older.

Advanced Beginner (Guidelines) Player must be able to hit 10 balls in a row against backboard from 20 feet away (forehand & backhand), rally with partner from the baseline 10 balls in a row each, serve 5 of 10 balls into appropriate service box, know how to keep score, and play a complete tennis match.

<u>Intermediate</u> (Guidelines) Player must be able to hit 20 balls in a row against backboard from 20 feet away (forehand and backhand), rally from baseline with partner 30 balls in a row, serve 6 of 10 serves to each service box, and must have played at least 5 complete tennis matches. Player must exhibit proper stroke mechanics and grips for all shots and must know the rules of tennis.

<u>Tournament Training</u> (Guidelines) Player must be able to maintain a baseline rally of 40 balls, properly execute volleys and overheads, and be able to execute flat, slice and kick serves. Players should also be training for high school or tournament competition.




