At our October Board meeting,

- We welcomed our newest member to the Board of Directors...Mary Manley. Mary and her family have lived in Forest Lakes for more than a decade. As an attorney, she brings new talents to your Board, as well as a commitment to our Forest Lakes community. Mary replaces outgoing Board member Fulton Gaylord. The Board extended appreciation for Fulton's service and leadership.
- The 2018 budget was approved by the Board at the meeting, and is now posted on the Forest Lakes Community Association website, www.forestlakes.net. Print copies are also available in the office.






Calling all readers! The Jefferson-Madison Regional Library Bookmobile comes to Forest Lakes twice each month, on the second and fourth Mondays. It parks by the North swimming pool and tennis courts from 2:00 - 2:45 pm. Through the Bookmobile, you have access to the entire JMRL collection of books, audiobooks, and movies. With your JMRL library card, you can also download e-books, audiobooks, and magazines and have access to our online databases.

The Bookmobile has its own collection and carries 1200 to 1500 books to each stop. We have books and audiobooks for all ages, including fiction and nonfiction, large print and regular. You can place holds on materials and pick them up at Forest Lakes. Books or other materials borrowed from the Bookmobile are checked out for one month and they can be renewed for a second month, if no one else is waiting for them. Materials borrowed from the Bookmobile may be returned to any J-MRL location and materials from other J-MRL locations may be returned to the Bookmobile.




