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#### FOREST LAKES TENNIS NEWS

#### FROM THE DESK OF JIM LABINSKI, DIRECTOR OF TENNIS

#### FEBRUARY 2021

We are in the tenth month of a pandemic...sigh. The FLCA Board has been very concerned with the safety and health of its residents. Closures and restrictions due to COVID-19 are in place all over—Forest Lakes is no exception. Early in the pandemic, the FLCA closed the tennis courts to residents only—no guests. Mainly, to put safety measures in place. More importantly, the no guest policy was put in place to make sure that Forest Lakes residents could have primary and exclusive access to this valuable exercise amenity during the pandemic! I'm happy to report that very few "outside" players have been able to sneak on the courts.

The pandemic gave rise to the KOURTS app for reserving courts. Only Forest Lakes residents that have been put on the KOURTS player list can book courts. It has come to my attention that some residents have been booking multiple courts for multiple hours and have been bringing in "outside" players to fill out their line-up. This prompted the "Residents Only" signs being placed at the entrances to the courts—not announcing a new rule, but rather, stating a friendly reminder of the policy that has been in place since April.

It is winter—not exactly prime time for tennis playing. But with COVID, the tennis courts are still very popular. To give players a little more flexibility in scheduling during the winter months, the duration of court times has been expanded.

At South, you can now book a court in 60-, 75- and 90-minute blocks. The 15-minute "intermission" period between court blocks has been eliminated. This was in place to allow for less interaction between players entering and exiting the court. Please be considerate of the next group of players and end your court time a few minutes early. At North, you can book a court in 60-, 75-, 90- and 120-minute blocks. Likewise, there is no "intermission" period between court bookings. Please be considerate and leave the court in better condition than when you arrived. Allocate enough time to brush and line your court. As always, please clean up any water/Gatorade, etc. bottles, tennis ball containers and the flip tops, and any other trash before you leave.

Finally, many tennis players are excited about the prospects of USTA league tennis returning in the spring and summer. This is a ways off and a lot can change over the next couple of months – we're keeping our eye on what other facilities are doing and the state of the pandemic. Keep your fingers crossed and we'll keep you posted!

When the FLCA Board loosens their restrictions on guests in the future, guests will once again be allowed to join Forest Lakes residents in their game. With the new and improved court surface coming to North, and with the continued and increased demand for court time at both sites, I anticipate court time to be at a premium in the warmer months ahead. The FLCA Board, the FLCA management and I will review the guest policy as we move forward.

Private, semi-private and group lessons are still available by appointment. Typically, I don't play when the temperature is less than 40 degrees. Check out your Weather Channel app and when the temperature is above 40 degrees, shoot me a text or an email and book a lesson.



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
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
