DUES AND ANNUAL MEETING REMINDERS

DUES: As stated in November's newsletter, there will be a 4.7% increase in dues for 2022. Beginning in January 2022 dues will be \$286.00 per quarter/\$1,144.00 annually. If you pay automatically through your bank, please don't forget to update the amount. If you pay through Klik 'n Pay, the payment should automatically update unless you've put a cap on the amount that can be withdrawn. Please contact the FLCA office should you have questions. Coupon booklets have been mailed and everyone should have received theirs by now. If you pay by Klik 'n Pay, you will not receive a booklet.

ANNUAL MEETING: The 2022 Annual Meeting date has been set for 6:00pm on Wednesday, January 26th at the Forest lakes Poolhouse. All Forest Lakes homeowners are invited to attend and should receive annual meeting information packets in the mail mid-December. In case of inclement weather, the meeting will be on February 2nd, 6:00pm, in the Poolhouse.

Whether or not you plan to come to the meeting (and we hope you do!) please remember to send your ballot in early in order to establish a quorum. If a quorum is not established, we'll have to re-send out all information which costs the homeowner's association money!

FOREST LAKES TENNIS AND PICKLEBALL NEWS

FROM THE DESK OF JIM LABINSKI, DIRECTOR OF TENNIS

DECEMBER 2021

Dear Forest Lakes residents,

I know the tennis season is winding down at Forest Lakes, and the clay court season didn't go down as we all had hoped. But I must say that I'm happy with the overall condition of the North Courts so far.

I'm so happy to have been able to teach you, your children, and your friends these past couple of years. Since we returned to the courts after the winter lockdown of 2020, tennis has provided a safe diversion for many of us. I hope this will continue.

Clay court update First, the good news: (at the writing of this newsletter) four of the North Courts have been resurfaced with new carpet and tons of clay court material. There are new sprinklers and new nets. There is a lot of material on each of the completed courts—you will get some bad bounces. However, you will not have to worry about breaking your neck tripping over a bad seam on the old courts.

Now, for the bad news: two of the North Courts have not been resurfaced (yet), and the water will be turned off for the winter very soon. Without the regular soaking of the courts, the newly-applied material will dry out.

The courts are definitely playable without the sprinklers and regular watering. The footing is superb—greatly improved with the new carpet and abundance of material. While playing on a dry clay court is not optimal, it can be done. You might need to brush the court in between sets to avoid the bad bounces.

Winter Tennis In a perfect winter, we'll get a light shower (or snow flurries followed by a quick melt) every couple of days, preferably while we're sleeping. The north courts will get matted down from Mother Nature and we will get to play on perfect clay courts!

Personally, I don't mind playing "winter tennis." My cut off is around 42 degrees. Windy conditions might also keep me off the courts in the winter. But with a few layers of clothing, there will be plenty of opportunities to keep your game in decent shape during the "off season."

Please continue to use the Kourts app to book your court reservations at both South and North. If you'd like to work on your game, I'm still available for group and private lessons by appointment. And if you play on the clay, you are still required to groom the court after you play.

Junior Tennis The Fall After School Tennis program was a huge success. It concluded on December 3. For the junior players that want to continue with their tennis over winter, I am available for private and group lessons when it's not too cold or windy.

If you'd like to continue with junior instruction, I urge you to contact your neighbors and friends, pick out compatible days and times, and play with me whenever the weather cooperates. Let me know if you're interested and I can help put together some groups.

Tennis lessons under the Christmas tree? Or maybe a new racquet! I have some new recreational Dunlop racquet priced at \$90 and \$100 that will be a perfect gift for the player that is looking for an economical upgrade to their current one.
