South Courts Update

The South Courts are open for tennis and pickleball play. There is one caveat: snow and ice may make this very difficult.

Scientific research (i.e., trial-and-error by yours truly) has discovered that Mother Nature is best for clearing the hard courts of snow and ice. In the past, I have cleared courts of snow—it typically takes several days! By the time all of the snow has been cleared off court one with back-breaking shoveling, the snow has usually melted and dried up on court three—all by itself!

My advice: be patient and give it a few days of sunshine and warmer temperatures. After Mother Nature has done her thing, there might be some unmelted snow in the shade. I would then bring a plastic shovel (please avoid the metaledged ones—scratches up the court surface) to clear those areas. You'll have to squeegee some water off before playing. Please return the squeegees to the fence.

North Courts Update

The North Courts are almost done!

Everyone knows the North Courts were supposed to be finished last spring. But because of *"dis, dat, and da utter ting"* (supply chain and staffing issues) they are not.

Before the cold temperatures came crashing in, the membrane and court material had been applied to five of the six courts. New sprinklers had been installed on two of the courts.

Obviously, this a moot point. With snow and ice covering the courts, no one is playing tennis for a while. When the temperatures get consistently above freezing for an extended period of time, the crew will return and finish the job. Hopefully, this will occur sometime in March. Tamera Hammond, FLCA Manager, will see to it!

Winter Lessons
