# Keeping in the Loop

## OUR POOLS HAVE OPENED

Our pools opened on Memorial Day weekend—and boy what a turnout! The heat brought everyone out for a cool respite. The food trucks on Saturday and Monday were visited often!

A few pool notes:

- **Cards:** The “No Card No Entry” policy is in effect at both pools. The guards are instructed not to let anyone in with no card. Telling them you forgot your card will not work. You must have it with you! Thank you for your cooperation. Still don’t have your pool cards? Contact the office.
- **Young Children:** Parents, if you have a child who has a floating device on, water wings, life jacket, etc., you must be always within arm’s reach of your child. It is your responsibility to make sure your child is safe in the water.
- **Parents:** Our pools are crowded, especially on hot, sunny days. Please keep an extra eye on your children, both in and out of the pools. It helps our guards tremendously and keeps our pools safer.
- **Guests:** Residents must always stay with guests. When you leave, they must leave too. Youth are allowed 2 guests per entry. Adults, if you have a party of 10 or more, please contact the office (this is a change from prior years).

## SWIM LESSONS

Please see the flyer in this newsletter for group swim lessons. We are doing morning-only lessons as afternoon thunderstorms have proved to be too disruptive in the past years. Instructor Laura Pace says that there are still some spots available in the last two sessions. Be sure to book yours now before they’re gone!

## EARLY MORNING SWIM

Early morning swim will begin on Tuesday, June 14th at the South pool from 6:30–7:30am. Lanes will be available on Thursdays as well, same time. We are also offering 4 lanes at the South pool on Saturday mornings from 9:30-11:00am. Morning swim lanes are for residents aged 16 and above.

## TENNIS AND PICKLEBALL UPDATES

North Court 5 is finally finished, which completes the overhaul of our north courts. Court 5’s fence will be fixed as soon as the fencing comes in (which we hear will be soon - fingers crossed). Once the fencing is up, the lights will be able to be fixed as well. Look for fully functioning north courts in June!

The pickleball courts have been lined at south and all seems to be going smoothly. A couple of tips: There should be no reason to move the portable pickleball nets. But if you do, please return them to the middle of the courts. Also, please read the helpful tip attached to each net—following these will ensure our pickleball nets last a long time. 

### Summer Tennis Camp

The Summer Tennis Camp will start on June 20, 2022. This is a nine-week program with plenty of options to customize your children's participation. Sign up for one week, four weeks, or the whole summer. Participants signing up for four weeks or more will receive a free t-shirt. ### The KOURTS APP – IT'S CHANGING!

The KOURTS App that we use to reserve our courts, has been acquired by "PLAYTOMICS". Beginning June 20<sup>th</sup>, the KOURTS app will no longer be available. You will need to download the PLAYTOMICS app. All of your information should migrate to the new app on June 20<sup>th</sup> and not before. If there is any additional information you will need, we will email it out via e-news. Are you signed up?

### The "Reopening" of the Clay Tech Courts at North

All of the Clay Tech courts at North are open for play! I am working on the courts between lessons to get the material evened out, and customizing the sprinklers for maximum coverage. Over the next few weeks, I will further tweak the amount of material on each of the courts and place risers under the irrigation pipes. This should help the water drain off the courts after a shower, and hopefully keep the material on the court. Do not step, kick or disturb the sprinklers and the irrigation pipes. Please inform me if you notice any disruption in the irrigation system. Remember to brush and line your court after playing on the North Courts. Save about ten minutes of your reserved time for doing this. Don't skip on your brushing! Be sure to make about three passes past the baseline and go beyond the doubles sidelines. Clean off the drag brooms of leaves and pine needles with the line scrub (the "tooth brush"). Hang up the drag broom and liner on the common fence near the gates. Leave the court as pristine as possible. It's a community effort.

### "But it's so hot"

In no time at all, when someone says "it's so hot," you'll respond with "it's not that bad." Imagine that! Participation during the summer months actually goes down a bit due to the heat. There are ways to beat the heat. Play earlier or stay late. Courts are available for reservations beginning at 8 am, though you can start earlier if that's your thing. Courts are bookable until 9 pm, but with an 8:59 pm zap of your Forest Lakes activity card you could play on your lighted court until 10:29 pm. Mid-day **play** is not recommended. Obviously, the hottest part of the day is not an ideal time to play for obvious reasons. Also, it takes a lot of water to have a moist, playable court between 1 and 3 pm and Kourts will not be taking reservations during this time.

Also, PRE-hydrate before play, hydrate while you play, and RE-hydrate after playing. Be sensible, take breaks often, or suspend play if the heat is too much for you. Don't be discouraged. After a few times in the grueling heat, you will get acclimated

### Cringeworthy!

I couldn't believe it! I've arrived at the North courts the other day, looking forward to a morning of lessons on the Clay Tech. And on court three, there are three youngsters playing soccer—wearing cleats! They were kindly asked to promptly leave. If you see someone, or some dog, using the tennis courts for something other than tennis, call them out. If you are uncomfortable reprimanding your neighbors (or "outside people"), put a call into the Forest Lakes Community Association office and they can handle it for you!

## Forest Lakes Swim Lesson Program Summer 2022

- Swim Lessons are for Forest Lakes residents only.
- Classes are held at the North Pool.
- Beginning May 28th, you may sign up for any class by emailing Laura Pace at **[laurapace06@icloud.com](mailto:laurapace06@icloud.com)**.
- Sessions will be one week Monday-Thursday with a Friday make up day for weather issues.
- Lessons will be 30 minutes with a maximum 5 children per session.
- The cost is \$40 per session.

**Level 1** (3 years and up) First class without a parent. Skills include floating, kicking, bobbing, arm movements, breath control, rolling over and safety.  
All skills are done with support.

**Level 2** (3 years and up) Must have completed Level 1 skills. Skills emphasized are rhythmic breathing, unsupported front/back floats and glides, finning, front crawl, elementary backstroke and safety.

**Level 3** (4 years and up) Must have completed Level 2 skills. Skills emphasized are front crawl with breathing to side, backstroke, treading water, butterfly kick, scissor kick, survival float and diving.

**Level 4** (5 years and up) Must have completed Level 3 skills. Skills emphasized are deep water bobbing, breast stroke, sidestroke, backstroke, butterfly and endurance in front crawl and elementary backstroke


