NEW MEASURING DEVICE AT HOLLYMEAD LAKE

You may have noticed a large pole "hiding" in the plantings along the hill on the Hollymead Lake dam. This pole has been installed by Albemarle County Environmental Services. The County received some free water level sensors through a federal/state program. Sensors have been installed at each of the County's six State-regulated dams as part of emergency preparedness efforts. Lake levels can now be observed from the Albemarle County Environmental Services offices and the system will notify staff when the lake level exceeds certain thresholds.
