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Forest Lakes neighbors:

Your Board has completed its annual financial review and approved the 2023 Annual Budget and Capital Expense items to be undertaken. Both are now available on the Forest Lakes website, www.forestlakes.net, in the password protected area (contact the FLCA office for password information if needed). For 2023 the annual homeowner assessment will be \$1198.00 or \$299.50 per quarter. FLCA management worked hard to minimize the increase given higher projected costs for pool operations and refuse collection in the current environment of elevated inflation. The assessment also includes an increase in the Reserves contribution we make to ensure that we have the funds needed to continue to repair, replace and reinvest in our community assets such as trails, pools, tennis courts, fitness equipment and buildings. The new assessment level is a 5% increase versus 2022, which is well below the current national inflation rate. Historically, FLCA assessments have increased at or below inflation and represent an outstanding value given the extensive community amenities and assets present here for residents to enjoy.

We appreciate the efforts of our FLCA management staff in keeping expenses well-controlled, managing our contracts tightly and ensuring we obtain good value and service levels. The community continues to be on strong financial footing, with the funds needed to keep our infrastructure and amenities in good condition and provide high-quality community services. Management and the board are also reviewing and updating FLCA financial policies to ensure that best practices are followed. Our goal is to keep Forest Lakes an outstanding community and a desirable, special place to live – maximizing our property values, recognizing there are more new communities being built in our area.

All homeowners are invited to attend the Annual Meeting, which will be held on January 25, 2023.

Piles do not decompose as fast as you may think and are unsightly, and our streams get clogged and bogged down when leaves are dumped into them. County Waste will take up to 10 bags of leaves

per trash pickup. This goes for sticks and branches too. Sticks must be cut down to a length of 3 feet and bundled for them to be picked up by County Waste.

DANCING WITH SMOVEY RINGS

We are welcoming back Smovey classes to Forest Lakes! Thursdays at the Poolhouse from 6:00-7:00pm. What are Smovey rings? Smovey rings were originally designed in Austria for people with neurological disorders such as Parkinson's. Smovey rings are a swinging ring system. They consist of a spiral tube with 4 steel balls and a cushioned grip. Their weight is a about 1 pound. The weight can be increased up to 10 pounds while swinging. The Smovey rings have multiple benefits: They provide a dynamic upper and lower workout, increase mobility, circulation, balance and coordination, strengthen muscles and stabilize the upper body and the spine. The swinging motion causes a vibration in the hands that stimulates the hand reflexologies, and it increases the Oi flow in the body. The Smovey rings have multiple benefits for all people and for all fitness levels and especially for people with neurological disorders such as Parkinson's, MS, Alzheimer's and Dementia. SLOW DOWN!!!

Do a "split stop" about three milliseconds after your opponent makes contact on his/her shot. Take another few milliseconds to assess or "read" the shot before making a mad dash to the ball. Maybe all you need is a skip and step. Take your time, do not rush. Good Luck.
