Neighborhood Notes

A FEW POOL NOTES:

- **Cards**: Residents are not to give their cards to anybody else in order to use our facilities. You MUST have your card to enter the pool. No card. No entry.
- Young Children: Parents, if you have a child who has a floating device on, water wings, life jacket, etc., you must be always within arm's reach of your child. It is your responsibility to make sure your child is safe in the water.
- **Parents**: Please go over the pool rules (included in the pool mailer) with your kids, especially those who are receiving youth cards for the first time.
- **Sunscreen**: Please do not lie on the chairs with sunscreen – place a towel between yourself and the chair. Also, take care not to spray sunscreen onto the pool chairs. The sunscreen develops a thick film on the chairs which darkens over time and becomes unsightly.
- **Guests**: Residents must always stay with guests. When you leave, they must leave too. Youth are allowed 2 guests per entry. Adults, if you have a party of 10 or more, please contact the office.

Park politely!

If you park your car, SUV, or truck by the tennis courts, please park politely. This includes leaving enough room so that pedestrians using the sidewalks can easily get by your vehicle. Also, turn off your lights! Tennis players are blinded by the headlights when your vehicle is facing the courts.

Use the Playtomic app and book your court

While "walk on" traffic is acceptable, it is NOT recommended. The court you walk onto might be reserved and you could get the boot. If you want to play, but forgot to book your court, check with me and I can book you a court—if one is available. With the nicer weather this time of year, the courts at both North and South will be very busy. Furthermore, there are several USTA team matches scheduled on weeknights (around 5:45) and Saturdays. Be sure to reserve your court in advance using the Playtomic app and don't be left out of the fun.
