Summer Tennis Camp kicks off June 19

The Summer Tennis Camp begins June 19. The camp runs for nine weeks. There are single-, four-, and nine-week options available. Get with the program. Book your court.

Are you still just walking on a court without making a Playtomic reservation? Get with the program. While "walk on" traffic is acceptable, it is NOT recommended. The court you walk onto might be reserved and you could get the boot. If you want to play, but forgot to book your court, check with me and I can book you a court—if one is available.

With school letting out soon, the courts at both North and South will be very busy. Furthermore, there are several USTA team matches scheduled on weeknights (around 5:45), Saturdays and Sundays. Be sure to reserve your court in advance using the Playtomic app and don't be left out of the fun.

You got to play the clay!

Have you played on the North Clay Tech courts lately? They are looking good and playing great! Be sure to reserve your court on the Playtomic app. There is a good chance I can pre-water your court and it will be in top shape for your game.

If rain is messing with your tennis plans, remember that after a Spring shower, you can get back on the court often in an hour or less. Nothing waters the Clay Tech courts at north like Mother Nature.

Don't forget to groom your court after you play. Remind others to do the same. The Court Fairy is on strike. Return the drag brooms and court liners to the designated area on the fence near the entrance gates. If you are new to the clay court scene, I can teach you the basics of grooming your court after play.
