Men's night and Women's night continue in August

Men's night and women's night clinics are starting back up in July. <u>Mondays</u>, August 17 and 24, men's night clinics will be conducted. Women's night clinics will take place <u>Thursdays</u>, August 3, 10 and 17. Cost is \$20 for 75-minute group lesson, or \$75 for a five-pack. These clinics will start at 6:30 pm and end at 7:45 pm.

My hope is to bring out 2.0-3.0 level men and women out on their respective nights and hit some balls in some easy lowkey drills. Guests, court bookings, canceling, and courtesy

Recently, the FLCA has seen a rash of misuse of the booking system. I would like to take this opportunity to clarify the policy on booking pickleball and tennis courts on the Playtomic app. Simply, for every court booked, there must be a minimum of one Forest Lakes players in the group—presumably the person that booked the court. You cannot book two courts under one name (or your name and your spouse's name) and bring seven guests to those courts. The Forest Lakes resident MUST be present on each court booked. No unaccompanied guests allowed.

Be prepared to leave your court at the finish of your allotted time. (Clay court maintenance is included in your court time—plan ahead.) If asked to leave by the next group, please do so in a swift and polite manner. Remember that YOU are responsible for your guests.

If your plans fall through and you can't make it to your court time, CANCEL your booking! Often, I will water a North court prior to the reserved time. If you cancel in a timely manner, it could save water! Also, canceling your court in a timely manner could open the court for someone else to use.

Ice water is provided as a courtesy to all players. It is recommended that you bring your own ice water in your favorite Stanley insulated tumbler, then refill it with "the coldest drinking water in Albemarle County." The paper cups are provided should you forget your designer water bottle. Reuse the cups whenever possible and don't be wasteful. Parents are encouraged to have their children bring a plastic cup or water bottle to the courts for lessons or play and refill as often as necessary.

Lately, I have heard more than the usual "outbursts" from players on the courts following a close line call. Remember The Code of Conduct for tennis states that in all matches that don't have a referee (which is ALL matches conducted at Forest Lakes) that the players are responsible for making calls. The need for your opponent to get glasses notwithstanding, you call the lines on your side of the court, I'll call the lines on my side of the court. Any doubtful calls go in your opponent's favor. All calls are made in good faith and should not be questioned.

Last I checked, nobody is playing for a million dollars. Lighten up on the calls all!
